Young Scholars seeks to help turn this dismal situation around with our Annual Village Event ***"Help A Brother Go 2 College Day."*** This event is geared toward current high school seniors and juniors; however sophomores may also attend.

Young men attending this event will have the opportunity to connect with college recruiters and hear about support services at various colleges to increase retention and graduation rates. They will also have the opportunity to apply to college, receive on the spot admissions from some colleges, and to get a jump start on the college application process.
