

West Contra Costa Unified School District Measure G Parcel Tax Senior Citizen Exemption Application Fiscal Year 2016-17

On November 6, 2012, the registered voters within the West Contra Costa Unified School boundaries approved Measure G. Measure G is a continuation of the previous parcel tax, Measure D. It will run for five years beginning July 1, 2014. The funds collected from Measure G is used to protect small class sizes, protecting core academic classes, retain excellent teachers, prepare students for post-secondary education paths, and school campus safety. Measure G allows a "Senior Citizen Exemption" for any parcel of taxable real property owned and occupied by at least one person 65 years of older.

To qualify for the senior citizen exemption, you must: 1) turn 65 years old before July 1, 2016; and, 2) own and occupy your property as your primary residence;

How to Apply for the Measure G Senior Citizen Exemption

- 1. Applications are available electronically, by email, by request, or in person:

 - Apply in person at <u>West Contra Costa Unified School District</u>, <u>1108 Bissell Avenue</u>, <u>Richmond, CA</u>
- 2. Complete the Measure G Senior Citizen Exemption Application and include the following documentation (*copies only*):
 - Proof of ownership (property tax bill)
 - Proof of residence (utility bill)
 - Proof of birth date (driver's license, birth certificate, or passport)
- 3. Mail the application and required documentation: Attn: Measure G Exemption, c/o Parcel Tax Administrator, 4745 Mangels Blvd, Fairfield, CA 94534 <u>no later than July 1, 2016</u>.

If you received your tax exemption in 2015-2016 and are still the homeowner and currently reside at the same address, you **do not** need to renew your tax exemption, it will automatically be renewed.

If you sold your home and purchased a new home, you must re-file for a Senior Citizen Exemption for the new property.



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To qualify for exemption from the parcel tax during any tax year (July 1 – June 30), <u>you must be age 65</u> <u>years old by July 1 of any applicable year, be the owner of the parcel, and use the parcel as your principal</u> <u>place of residence</u>. If you believe you will qualify for this exemption, please complete and return this form to the **WCCUSD Measure G Exemption**, **4745 Mangels Blvd**, **Fairfield**, **CA 94534**, **by** <u>July 1, 2016</u>.
