Parent Meeting El Cerrito High School – Bruce Harter

Manzanita Charter Petition Review - Wendell Greer

Manzanita Charter Middle submitted a petition to WCCUSD in 1999 to open in the year 2000 for a term of five years. The charter was renewed for five years in March 2005, and again in March of 2010. The organization submitted a renewal petition, and stemming from requests for further information from staff, has decided to defer the decision hearing initially scheduled for April 1, 2015. The renewal decision hearing will take place during the regularly scheduled Board meeting of April 22, 2015.

New Change Order Procedure – Lisa LeBlanc

In response to the Board requesting additional information relating to change orders, a new change order procedure is being established. All change orders which cause a project's contract cost to exceed 10%, or are of an individual value of \$250,000 or more, will be considered for ratification by an action item containing more detail on the change after review by the Facilities Subcommittee. Change Orders No. 3, 4 and 5 for the Ohlone ES playground and parking lot project will be an action item for the Board on the April 1, 2015 agenda. The new procedure will be fully implemented commencing with the April 14, 2015 Facilities Subcommittee meeting.

CA Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act ("CUPCCAA") – Lisa LeBlanc On the April 1, 2015 Board consent agenda, the Board is being requested to ratify staff awarded projects. As background for this item, the Board previously approved Resolution #90-0809 on May 20, 2009, to become subject to CUPCCAA. The acceptance of this resolution benefits the

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District in many ways identified by the State Controller's Office including: access to informal bidding procedures; streamlined awards process; and improved timeliness of project completion and simplified administration. CUPCCAA requires the District to follow established bidding procedures and accounting guidelines set forth under Public Contracts Code Section 22000 through 22045. The maximum informal bid limit is currently \$175,000. The informal bid requirements include yearly notice inviting all licensed contractors to submit required information for inclusion on the qualified bidders list and a notice inviting bids at least 10 days before bids are due to all specified trade journals. CUPCCAA also allows the Governing Board to delegate authority to award informal contracts to specific staff members: Superintendent, Superintendent's designee.
