College/Career Center

College/Career Readiness

Rising Scholars: Our college career advisors along with our academic counselors identify, recruit, and support students of color to participate in this college readiness programs.

WCCUSD has partnered with the Young Scholars Program to create the Rising Scholars Project (9-12), a subsidiary of the Young Scholars Program. The Rising Scholars Project is a project to increase the number of Young Men of Color who matriculate to college and successfully move toward degree attainment.

College Scholarships: Paying for college can be an overwhelming thought! Hercules High School Counselors are ready, willing and able to guide you in the right directions so you can complete all the scholarship applications you want. Academic Counselors/EAOP/DCAC

College applications are open - counselors have been working with seniors on their applications, essays, personal statements and questions, and recommendation letters, meeting individually and in groups.

Counselor interns have been meeting one on one with Freshmen, completing 4 year plans on OverGrad.com and a career/interest inventory on www.cacareerzone.org. Seniors in need of making up a D or F, either to remain eligible for college admission, or to be qualified to graduate, have been enrolled in an online course through Edmentum. College admissions reps from 4 year institutions have scheduled visits on campus and usually held in the theater. Sign ups are through the counselors.

College Career Center (EAOP/DCAC)

Juan Rosales is our new EAOP/DCAC advisor for 2017-18. Mr. Rosales has introduced himself to the EAOP cohort which ranges from 10-12th grade. In addition, I have created a College Success Plan which lays ground for them to complete the A-G requirements. Senior cohort has been getting help with college applications, essays, financial aid questions and College, Major, and Career Exploration. These presentations will be open for the entire senior class and I have been helping any senior that asks for help. The school has been registered for The Graduate For Mas challenge which will further help us promote the College Going Culture. This provides a gamified approach to college information in which students can redeem their points for prizes.

We are pleased and excited to announce the continued deployment of our 2-in-1 personal tablets (Lenovo/Acer) to all students (9-12) at Hercules High School. The intent is for each student to "check-out" a 2-in-1 laptop tablet that can be used in the classroom as well as at home. Teachers will be utilizing a variety of online resources and technological tools to support instruction, assignments, projects, research and assessment. Our transition into technology based learning will enhance student engagement through the development of critical thinking, collaboration and communication skills. The immediate access to computers and the increased use of technology throughout all courses, will have a beneficial effect on teaching and learning.

All students will need to have completed the <u>WCCUSD Student Acceptable Use Policy</u> and the Student <u>Agreement for Use of Electronic Mobile Devices</u>. Both technology forms are attached for your convenience. **Please read and sign the back of each form and return to the main office or to the library.** Once all the proper forms have been turned in, students will check out a 2-in-1 laptop tablet and charger just like they would check out textbooks.



ACADEMIC INTERVENTION

Homework Center — Achieve Learning Tutorial Services staff 3 individuals to support English, Math and Science. The homework center is open to all students and occurs every T, Th, and Friday from 3:30pm—4:30pm. In addition, we have a 9th grade algebra intervention program to support students struggling with the mastery of algebra I concepts.

Edmentum: an online credit recovery program available to 10th, 11th and 12th grade students who are in need of repeating a previously failed course. Edmentum offers courses in English, Math, and Social Science. In order for students to complete "A-G" course requirements for UC/CSU entrance criteria, they must pass each course taken with a "C" or better.
