

# UC Application Tip Sheet

## HIGH SCHOOL COURSEWORK:

You will not have very many high school classes to input. Each grade level you're putting high school classes you will have about 3 classes for each year; English, Geometry, Algebra 1, Biology, Spanish, US and World History. All your college classes will have CCC after it on your MCHS transcript. However; you will NEED your unofficial CCC transcript for courses not on your MCHS transcript.

ALL high school classes should be NH (Not Honors) -MCHS doesn't offer AP or IB since college courses trump those.

Do not mark them as CL (College Level)

Use SEMESTER not Quarter System

Scroll down to "I Don't See My Courses" to input Senior Project NH

S1 (semester 1)

S2 (semester 2)

IP (In Progress)

PL (Planned)

For Govt/Econ, make sure you put in IP (in progress) if you're in Govt or Econ this semester and NO (no grade) for the second semester. See example below.

## COLLEGE COURSEWORK:

ALL CCC courses must have CL (College Level) not NH (Not Honors)

Any CCC courses under 3 units you do not need to put in. They will not count toward the UCs anyway. Examples of courses under 3 units: BOT 210A, PE, Physics 110 LAB, etc. (use your CCC unofficial transcript to check the units for each course).

Math 118, Math 120 and Math 121 Do NOT transfer to a UC, so there is no need to put those courses in.

Make sure to input your current (Fall 2020) CCC courses. Your Spring courses will need to be put in as well but that won't happen until I make your Spring 2021 schedule (this means you should not be submitting your application until you've registered for Spring 2021 CCC courses). Example:
