


### West County Unified School District Parcel Tax



### 2004

The parcel tax was first approved by West County voters in 2004 to save athletics, libraries and guidance counselors. West County residents voted to renew the parcel tax in 2008 and 2012.

## \$9.8 Million

Property owners pay 7.2¢ per square foot of total building area per parcel (Senior citizens and disabled are exempt), which raises \$9.8 million each year to support the 32,300 students who attend public schools in the District.



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35% of the revenue funds counselors, school psychologists, and special education teachers

25% funds librarians, library assistants

15% funds class size reduction in the primary grades

12% funds athletics

7% funds textbooks and teaching materials

6% funds custodial services
