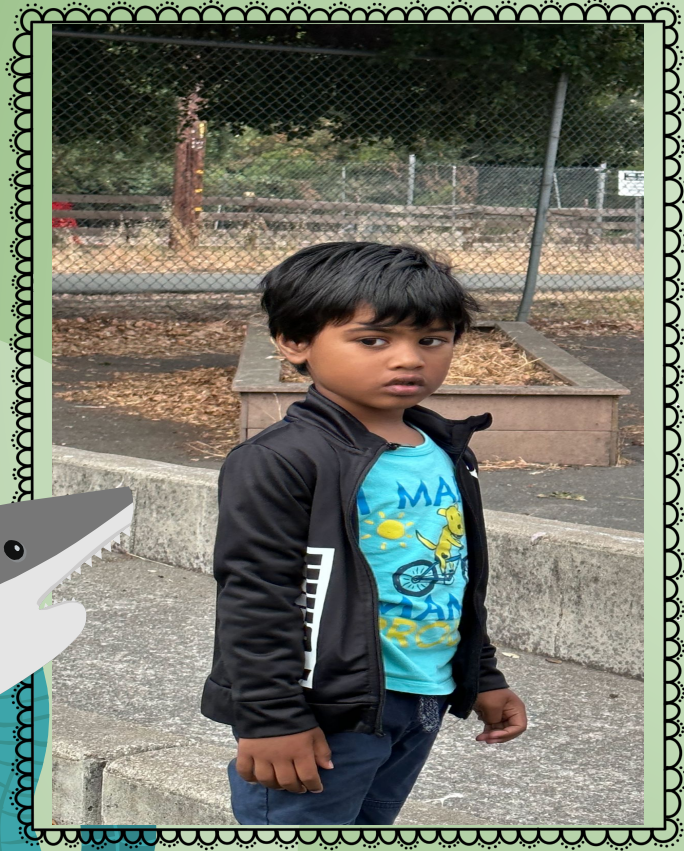


BEING RESPECTFUL

Ms. Mendoza | ESN

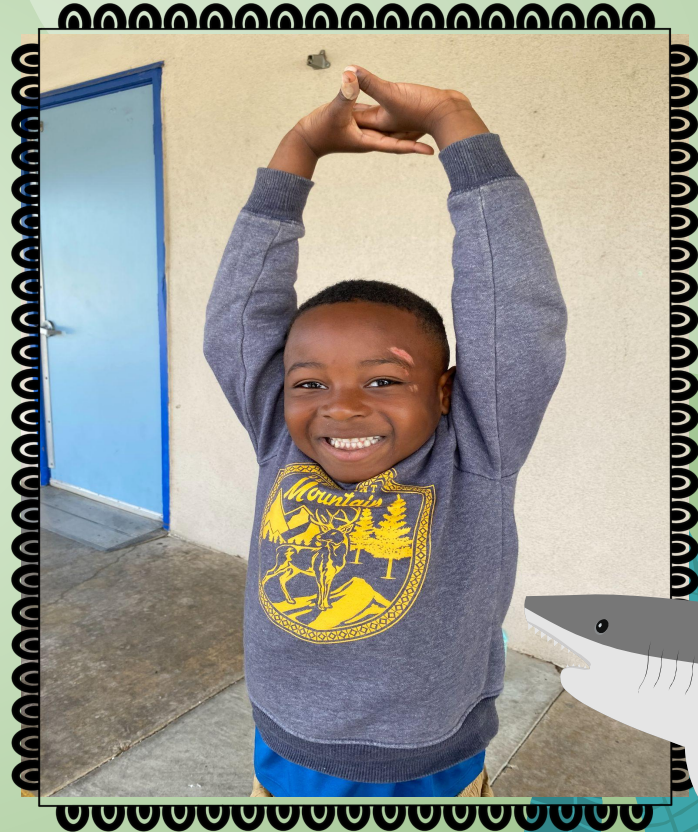

MICHAEL

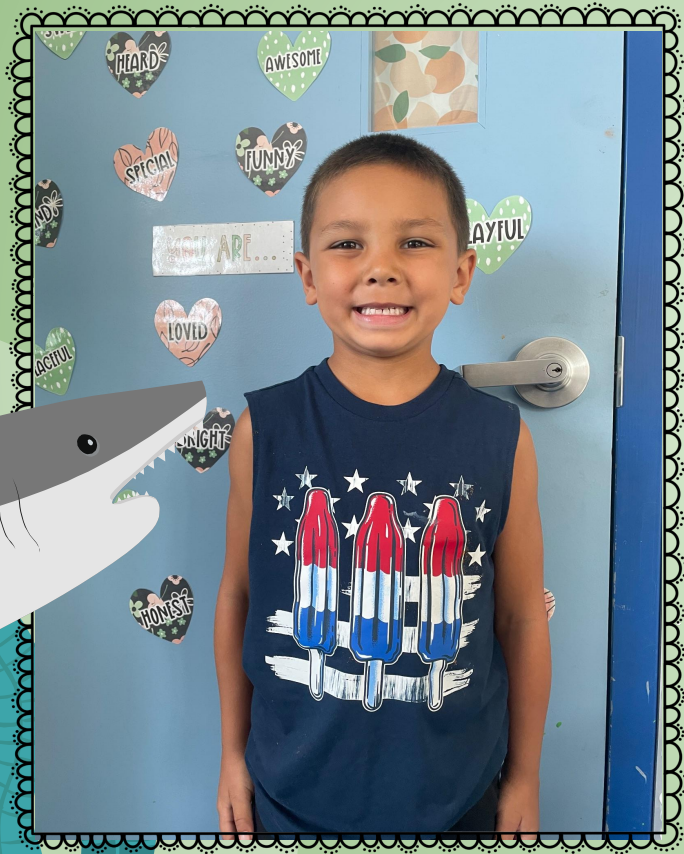
Ms. Sylvia | TK

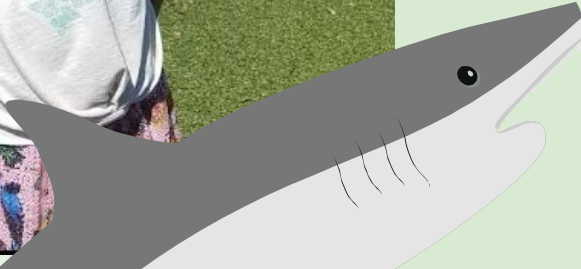


MILA

Ms. Berenguer | 1st Grade



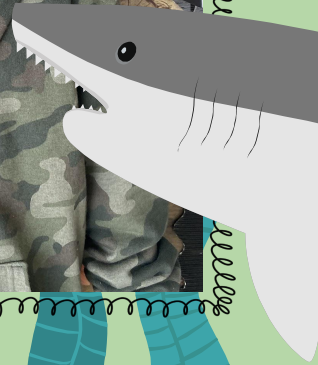

JOSAFAT

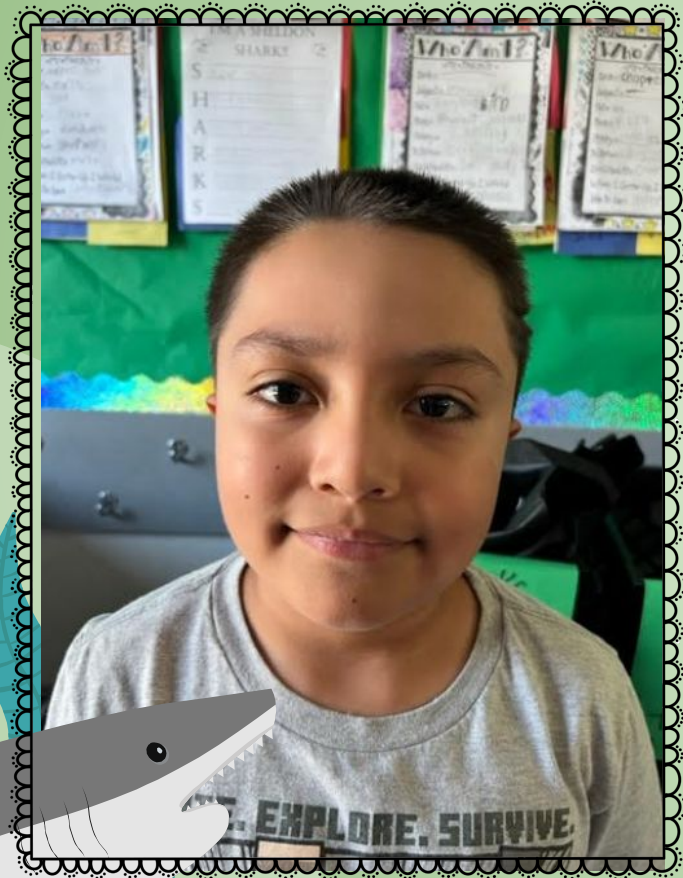
Ms. Howard | 1st Grade

ADRIANA

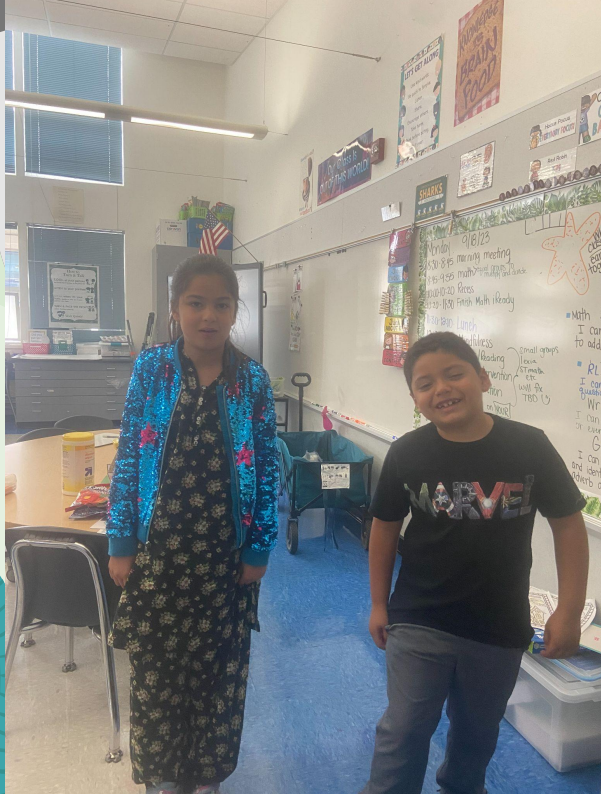
Ms. Murphy | 2nd Grade

Azeneth

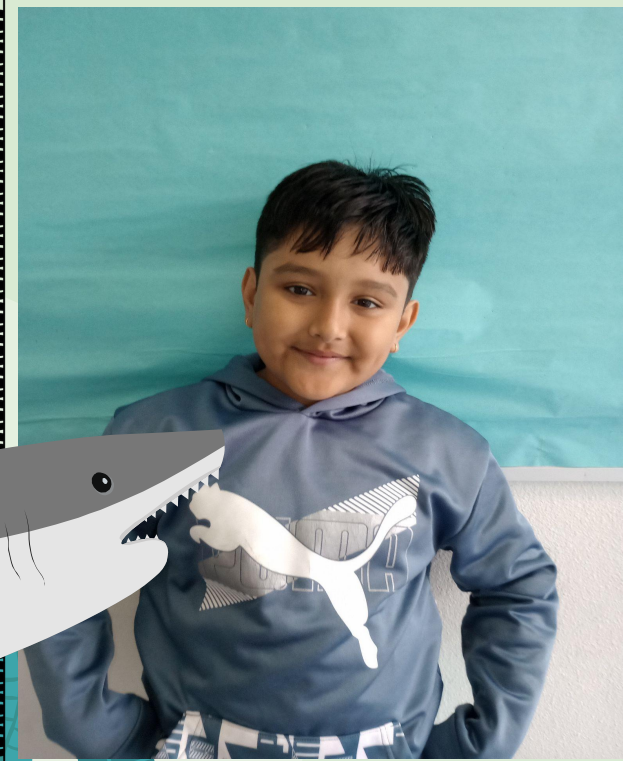
Ms. Wolfman | 3rd Grade
