

MIDDLE COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT ENROLLMENT CONTRACT

As a MCHS student, I agree to all of the following expectations:

- Make education a high priority in my life, including positive participation in class and school activities, and working to achieve and exceed my potential.
- Be punctual and maintain exceptional attendance in all high school and college classes.
- Take responsibility for my own learning, behavior, and success.
- Devote a minimum of **two hours** each evening to homework, studying, and reading.
- Behave in a manner that shows respect for everyone in the school community-students, staff, visitors-and the rights of others to learn and succeed, as well as the college and school facilities and equipment.
- Maturely handle the freedoms and scheduling of a college setting, and understand that my existence on the college campus is a privilege, not a right.
- Demonstrate the ability to make mature, independent, productive choices, and accept responsibility for those choices.
- Adhere to the technology agreements of CCC and WCCUSD.
- Comply with MCHS rules and regulations outlined in the MCHS Student Handbook and Planner.
- Maturely handle flexible scheduling and be able to make productive use of unscheduled time. I understand that MCHS is a closed campus and that I will not leave campus at any time without prior approval and/or notification to the main office by a parent/guardian.
- Adhere to the Ed Plan and not add/drop or be dropped from any class without prior approval from the MCHS counselor.
- Complete all WCCUSD and MCHS graduation requirements.
- Plan to continue in college after graduation.
- Keep parents informed of my academic progress at MCHS.
- To be placed on probation and be obligated to attend mandated tutoring for the **semester** if quarter marks on **any** report card fall below a “C”.
- Recognize and understand that MCHS has no organized athletics. If I wish to engage in high school sports off campus, I may play for my school of residence with prior written approval from the principal and agree to maintain a GPA of 3.0. Students placed on academic probation will have their approval revoked.
- **Understand that I may be referred to another WCCUSD school if I do not:**
1) Maintain a 2.8 grade point average in high school classes and/or earn a mark lower than a “C” in a college class; and/or 2) Comply with MCHS and CCC rules and regulations.
- **MCHS HAS A VERY STRICT DISCIPLINE POLICY, AS SUCH, STUDENTS CAN AND WILL BE SUSPENDED, EXPELLED, AND/OR DROPPED TO THEIR SCHOOL OF RESIDENCE. THIS INCLUDES A SINGLE VIOLATION.**
