National Assessment Educational Progress (NAEP)

The NAEP is a measure of student achievement that allows you to compare student performance in California with that of students across the nation. The NAEP tests students in grades four, eight, and twelve in subjects such as reading, writing, math, and science. Schools are randomly selected by the state and a sample of students are tested at the school site by NAEP staff. This year, the following schools were selected: El Cerrito High, Richmond High
