The NAEP is a measure of student achievement that allows you to compare student performance in California with that of students across the nation . The NAEP tests students in grades four, eight, and twelve in subjects such as reading, writing, math, and science. Schools are randomly selected by the state and a sample of students are tested at the school site by NAEP staff. This year, the following schools were selected: Olinda, Stewart, Korematsu and Pinole Middle.
