College & Career Day

This year, College & Career Day is on Wednesday, October 10th!

TK-9th grade students participate in College Day activities implemented by sites including special assemblies, College T-Shirt Day, games, or college visits.

Students in 10th – 12th grade take the **SAT Suite of Assessments**, which measure the reading, writing and mathematical knowledge and skills critical for success in college and career.

- 10th-11th graders will take the PSAT/NMSQT—includes 3 tests (Reading, Writing and Language, and Math) with multiple-choice and student-produced or grid-in questions; testing time is 2 hours and 45 minutes.
- 12th graders will take the SAT college admission test, which includes three sections: Evidence-based Reading and Writing, Math and an essay. Testing time is 3 hours 50 minutes.
