PSAT/SAT School Day Assessments Parent Information

All grade 10-12 parents will receive a flyer with details about College Day assessments (PSAT/NMSQT, SAT School Day) and a link to create a parent account to join Khan Academy.

Khan Academy, an online system, helps train students from K-12 on the subjects needed to succeed in college & career: reading, math, and beyond. WCCUSD students can use Khan Academy for free www.khanacademy.org.

PSAT /SAT School Day Testing

This year, SAT School Day is on Wednesday, **October 16th!**

Students in 10th – 12th grade take the **SAT Suite of Assessments**, which measure the reading, writing and mathematical knowledge and skills critical for success in college and career.

- **10th-11th** graders will take the **PSAT/NMSQT**—includes 3 tests (Reading, Writing and Language, and Math) with multiple-choice and student-produced or grid-in questions; testing time is 2 hours and 45 minutes.
- **12th** graders will take the **SAT** college admission test, which includes three sections: Evidence-based Reading and Writing, Math and an essay. Testing time is 3 hours 50 minutes.

NEW! ELPAC CB Field Test October 7-25, 2019

WCCUSD will field test the new ELPAC computer-based assessment which will become operational in the spring of 2020. The purpose of the field test is to gather test response data representing diverse geographic locations throughout the state. We also want to become familiar with the new CB format to get a jump on the spring administration.

The RAP Center will test approx. 160 students across 8 schools. DeAnza, Richmond, Helms, DeJean, Chavez, Downer, Dover, Grant. Schools will be notified of testing information soon.
