

Elementary Instrumental Music Department



Dear Parent: 8/25/16

An Instrumental Music program will be offered again this year in our elementary schools. The Instrumental Music Department will offer Beginning and Intermediate instruction in **flute**, **clarinet**, **trumpet**, **and trombone**.

If your child is a beginner, please wait until we are able to interview your child and assist him/her in selecting the instrument that may be best for them before renting or purchasing. Many students often want to switch to another instrument after only a year of instruction. We discourage this since it takes several years of practice on one instrument before an elementary student has reached an intermediate level.

Many students in the program rent or own their instruments. Instruments can be rented from local music stores listed in the yellow pages. A limited number of school instruments are available. Many more students request instruments than there are instruments available, especially flutes, clarinets, and saxophones. Not all students can be provided with a school instrument. If your child can provide his/her own instrument, he/she will automatically be enrolled in the music program. Students requesting the use of school instruments will be entered into a lottery. If your child played an instrument last year and demonstrated an aptitude and a willingness to practice, then purchasing or renting to buy an instrument would be a wise investment in your child's education. Instrumental Music is a Pull-Out class that removes students from their regular classroom activities once or twice a week for 30 minutes each time.

Students are required:

- 1. To attend each class session with their instrument and music materials. Even 1 missed class can put a student seriously behind.*
- 2. To practice 30 minutes each day.
- 3. To exhibit good behavior, (self-control and listening), in each class session.*
- 4. To make up any classroom assignments missed due to being taken out of class in order to participate in instrumental music.
- * Chronic Failure to comply may lead to being dropped from the Program after a Parent Conference.
