Course scheduling for 2015-16: All students are able to log-on to PowerSchool and select their courses for the next school year! If you are not sure what courses your son or daughter should be in for 2015-16 school year, please email your counselor or have them schedule an appointment to get assistance with their course selection process.

Contra Costa College admissions office was on campus to help seniors apply and enroll for college this fall. College representatives have also been on campus to administer the assessment test that is required for placement in English and Math to the students who enrolled for the fall.

We had a representative from Cal State East Bay on campus this month. She, along with the counselors, went into all of the Junior English classes to present information about EAP. The upcoming SBAC assessment that the juniors will be taking next month is linked to the CSU Early Assessment Program. The juniors' scores on the SBAC can qualify students to go directly into college level math and English classes at all of the CSU campuses, and 90 of the California Community College campuses. The juniors were encouraged to study for the assessment and do their very best.

SBAC Testing

The new Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium test will be administered throughout April this year. All 11th grade students will complete the exam in both English and Math. The exam replaces the CST's and STAR exams given in prior years. The exams measure students' proficiency in meeting the high school standards from 9th through 11th grade.
