



Citizens Oversight Committee for Parcel Tax (COCPT) Recruitment Application

Purpose

The purpose of the Committee is to review the annual audit of parcel tax expenditures and prepare an annual report to the Board which reconciles parcel tax expenditures with programs and positions funded by the tax measure(s). The committee will also review enrollment and expenditure data from charter schools to ensure those schools are in compliance with the authorizing provisions of the measure(s).
