- For every teacher to have a teacher's aide

Teacher/Staff Support

- Lower teacher turnover
- More competitive salaries: admin, teacher, classified
- More support at schools: ie some sites VPs some sites clerks, etc

Whole Child

- Better sports equipment
- Full time playworks
- Increase after school programs within district (*free in Richmond but not other cities
- Quality instruction in all classrooms

Safety

Break-away gates

School Support

- Support for college going culture
- More H.S. Counselors
- Smaller class sizes in secondary schools

Parent Involvement

- Parent engagement
- School site councils
- Communication with parents, staff, principal, teachers, students
