

West Contra Costa Unified School District Measure G Parcel Tax Supplemental Security Income (SSI) Exemption Application Fiscal Year 2020-21

In November 2016, the registered voters within the West Contra Costa Unified School boundaries approved Measure T. Measure T is a continuation of the previous parcel tax, Measure G. The parcel tax will run for eight years beginning July 1, 2019. The funds collected from Measure T is used to protect small class sizes, protecting core academic classes, retain excellent teachers, and prepare students for post-secondary education paths. Measure T allows for a "SSI Exemption" for any Parcel of Taxable Real Property owned and occupied by Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipients.

To qualify for the SSI Exemption, you must: (1) receive SSI; and, 2) own and occupy your property as your primary residence;

How to Apply for the Measure T SSI Exemption

- 1. Applications are available electronically, by email, by request, or in person:

 - Call the Parcel Tax Administrator at (844) 332-0549 for application by mail
 - Apply in person at <u>West Contra Costa Unified School District</u>, 1400 Marina Way South, <u>Richmond, CA 94804</u>.
- 2. Complete the Measure T SSI Exemption Application and include the following documentation (copies only):
 - Proof of ownership (property tax bill)
 - Proof of residence (utility bill)
 - A copy of your Benefits Verification Letter (<u>*A Benefits Verification Letter may be obtained by</u> calling the Social Security Administration at (800) 772-1213 or by visiting a local Social Security Administration Office.)
- 3. Mail the application and required documentation: Attn: Measure T Exemption, c/o Parcel Tax Administrator, 4745 Mangels Blvd, Fairfield, CA 94534 <u>no later than July 1, 2020</u>.

Any property owner who receives the SSI exemption will need to submit a copy of the benefits verification letter to the Parcel Tax Administrator on an annual basis.

If you sold your home and purchased a new home, you must re-file for the SSI exemption for the new property.
