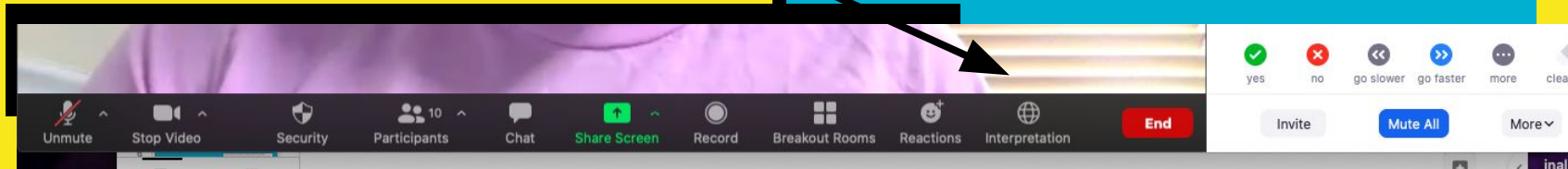

Optional Spring In-person Intervention

- All families **MUST** complete their intent to return [survey here!](#)
 - Please complete even if you do NOT want your child to participate.
- We are offering intervention **ONLY** from 2-3:45pm Monday-Wednesday
 - This is based on participating staff- all students and staff can participate on a voluntary basis.
 - We will invite the highest priority students **FIRST**. If slots are still available, we will then begin reaching out to families interested who complete the survey above.
- **COVID safety measures will be taken**
 - All staff/students will wear PPE and have their temperature taken daily.
 - Parents must complete a health screener before sending their child.
 - We will have an isolation room with a CPR certified adult for any child displaying symptoms.
 - Intervention groups will be limited to no more than 10 students and 1 adult/cohort
 - Contact tracing will be implemented for staff

Summer school will also be in-person and look similar to these intervention groups. We are currently working on our list of students who will be invited and reaching out soon.

California schools are currently petitioning the state legislature to forego state testing this year due to COVID and distance learning. If the state doesn't approve this proposal, we will need to test students in grades 3-6 in Math and ELA. 5th grade also takes a science test.

Las escuelas de California están solicitando actualmente a la legislatura estatal que renuncie a las pruebas estatales este año debido al COVID y el aprendizaje a distancia. Si el estado no aprueba esta propuesta, necesitaremos evaluar a los estudiantes en los grados 3-6 en matemáticas y ELA. El quinto grado también toma un examen de ciencias.

Taking care of Technology

- It is VERY important students take care of their iPads.
- This includes the cords and the cases
- iPad charges are \$750, cords are \$10 and cases are \$50

iPads are to be used for school work only

Students should not:

- **CHANGE THEIR PASSWORDS.** Admin works hard to ensure it is easy for students to access their iPads. If passwords are changed (and forgotten), we need to have Apple unlock them which can take a long time
- Download unapproved Apps
- Take photos or videos unrelated to school work
