- Applicants must be available for an interview appointment by Zoom.

## **Application form** should be completed and returned together with:

- 1. Short answers to the six application questions.
  - 1. How would you define the Gaucho spirit and how it has helped you in high school?
  - 2. What do you consider your biggest personal triumph?
  - 3. What do you do outside of school?
  - 4. What are your career goals?
  - 5. Looking back on your year of virtual learning, how would you sum up the experience?
  - 6. How has El Cerrito helped you with your time management skills?
- One single sided page essay answering:
  - How has your experience at El Cerrito High School prepared you for your future?
  - How do you see yourself giving back to your school and community?
- 3. Two letters of recommendations, each not to exceed one page:
  - El Cerrito High School faculty or staff member
  - Member of the community or employer
