## Welcome to the Fred T. Korematsu (formerly Po El Cerrito Middle School Name Change

RICHMOND -- Portola Middle School in El Cerrito will be renamed Fred T. Korematsu Midcivil rights leader.

The decision was made by the West Contra Costa School District board. A committee, n Ramsey, board member Randy Enos and El Cerrito resident Jim Ghidella, recommended to testimony at four community meetings and two school board meetings. Korematsu, w convicted in 1942 for defying the order to transport residents of Japanese ancestry to attack on Pearl Harbor.

Korematsu's conviction was overturned by a federal court in 1983, and he was awarded President Bill Clinton in 1998. Ghidella said the idea to rename the school after Koremat bring the matter up before the full board in April. Ghidella said he embraced the conce community, many of whom were active in the flower growing industry in El Cerrito and internment. The new name will present an opportunity to teach about a regrettable an history, he said.

"Two out of seven El Cerrito residents are Asian," he said. "This is a whole side of U.S. h school."

The proposal had generated some division and controversy, but at a recent meeting, ni Superior Court Judge Joni Hiramoto, favored the name change.


