## EXECUTIVE REPORT REGARDING ADOPTION OF FINAL PLAN

Pursuant to the terms of the Stipulated Judgment entered between the District and the Plaintiff in *Ruiz-Lozito v. West Contra Costa Unified School District*, Contra Costa Super. Ct. Case No. C18-00570, and in accordance with its obligations under state and federal law, including but not limited to the federal Voting Rights Act, the California Voting Rights Act, and the California Education and Election Codes, the West Contra Costa Unified School District Independent Redistricting Commission (“Commission”) hereby adopts the attached trustee area map as its Final Plan.

The Commission has considered the criteria set forth in the Stipulated Judgment and determined that the Final Plan both satisfies those criteria and provides an appropriate basis for its subsequent work. The Commission finds that:

- (a) The Final Plan complies with the population equality requirements of the United States Constitution and California law, because the population of each individual district is within 3.89 percent of the average district population.<sup>1</sup>
- (b) The Final Plan complies with the Federal Voting Rights Act by establishing or maintaining multiple trustee areas in which members of protected classes either (1) constitute a majority of the voters within the district or (2) constitute a near majority of voters in the district or can act in coalition with members of other protected classes in the district in order to elect their candidates of choice and influence elections on a basis more equal to the opportunity enjoyed by the rest of the electorate.<sup>2</sup>
- (c) The Final Plan appropriately accounts for the District’s topography and geography; the cohesiveness, contiguity, integrity, and compactness of each trustee area; and the geographic integrity of neighborhoods and communities of interest.<sup>3</sup>

The Commission has not considered the place of residence of any incumbent or political candidate, and the trustee areas have not been drawn for the purpose of favoring or discriminating against an incumbent, candidate, or political party.

Under the term’s of the Stipulated Judgment, the Commission was not required to consider the temporary Trustee Area map established for use in the November 2020

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Trustee Area elections when adopting a new Plan. Nonetheless, in order to assist the public in understanding the Commission's new Plan, the Commission's retained demographer provided a comparison of the Recommended Plan to the 2020 Trustee Area Map [on his website](#). As detailed in the demographics report therein, the population changes identified by the 2020 United States Census resulted in a substantial (approximately six percent) population deviation as between the 2020 map's Trustee Area 3 and the remaining Trustee Areas. The Final Plan adopted by the Commission reduces that deviation to less than four percent, and also provides greater opportunities for members of protected classes to elect candidates of their choosing, particularly in Trustee Areas 2 and 3.<sup>4</sup>

The Commission's legal counsel shall immediately transmit a copy of this Executive Report, as well as with the shape file associated with the chosen map, to the District's Superintendent, who shall make it publicly available.

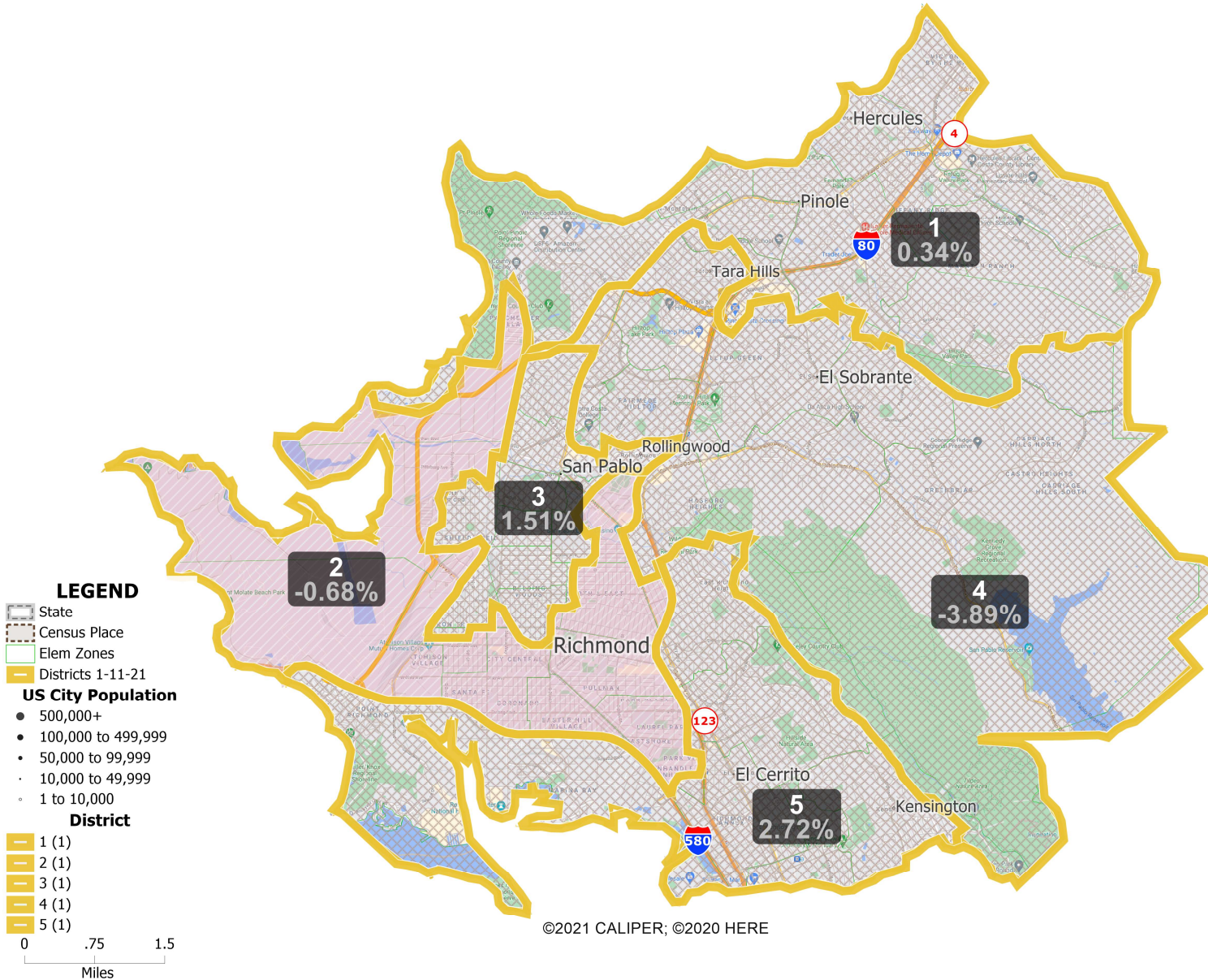

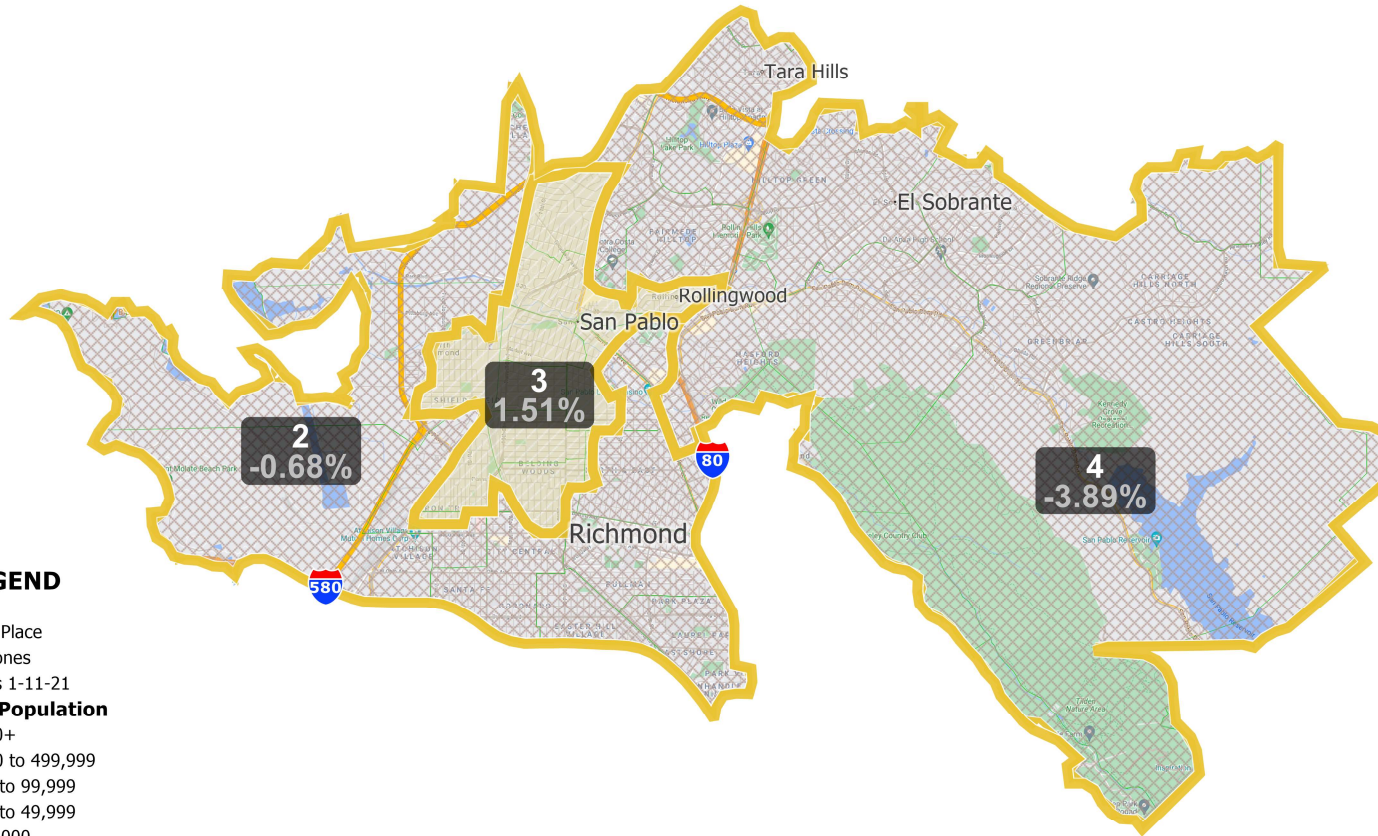
