Welcome back! What a thrilling time to be a Verde community member! We are excited to kick-off our school year stronger than ever.

Our foci for 2017-18:

Vision

- Our vision is critical to our Verde community. We purpose all of our effort to achieving our vision of:
- A professional learning community of collaborative thinkers focused on high achievement and embracing the whole child so that students grow academically and socially in a safe and positive environment to become college graduates, leaders, and lifelong learners.

Theory of Action

We employ a strong theory of action to guide us toward vision. We focus our work in three areas, school culture and climate, adult collaboration and learning, and teaching and learning. Further, we keep our work grounded with a focus on equity, diversity, and community.

Student Achievement

- o Our school works relentlessly to increase achievement.
 - We reclassified four times as many English Learners in 2016-17 as we did in 2014-15!
 - We doubled the amount of students meeting or exceeding standard on the SBAC in math and literacy!
- We will continue to drive toward outstanding student achievement in 2017 18 and keep it our number one priority.
 - We will focus on facilitating a robust writing workshop in every classroom K-6 daily.

Student Rights and Responsibilities

All students are worthy human beings deserving of respect and the best efforts of the school staff. Student rights must be vigorously respected and protected at all times. In turn, all students have certain obligations to follow the culture of high expectations, be contributing participants in the learning process, and to be good citizens within the school community.

The basic rights of students at all grade levels include the following:

- To be safe.
- To be respected as individuals.
- To be treated fairly and without prejudice.
- To learn without disturbance or distraction.
- To have personal property respected and protected.
- To express views and to be heard.
- To be challenged with materials and instructional techniques commensurate with their abilities and learning styles.
- To be free from harassment.
- To learn in a drug-free, smoke-free, and violence-free environment.
- To be called with respect what they choose (i.e. African American, Hispanic, etc.)
- To have access to appropriate grievance procedures.

If any student feels that their rights have been violated they have the responsibility to immediately report it to their teacher or the principal. It is our goal that every student feels welcomed and safe at Verde Elementary.

Volunteer Policy

We welcome parent and community volunteers and see them as partners in our goal to meet the high academic expectations we have for scholars. West Contra Costa Unified School District requires that all volunteers submit to screening and obtain a district badge to perform any school volunteer activity or be on campus for an extended period time. Furthermore, parents and community members making regular contact with students and parent chaperones on fieldtrips are considered volunteers. An on-line application, fingerprinting and conducting a Department of Justice background check are part of the process, however, are FREE to families and community members. Visitor Policy

Parents and community members are welcome to visit their child's classroom for extended periods of time with a district volunteer badge and 20 minutes or less without a badge. To ensure visitations are productive for both school and visitors, please follow these guidelines:

- 1. All visitors **must** register in the school office (Ed. Code Section 3221) prior to visiting the classroom or playground.
- 2. Wear WCCUSD volunteer badge or visitor badge in a visible place.
- 3. Provide prior notice to teachers and staff at least 24 hours in advance.
- 4. We ask that you do not interrupt the classroom schedule by going directly to the classroom. **All contact with students should be made through the office.**
- 5. Hallways need to clear in the morning and all adults/students need to wait for teacher pick up in the cafeteria or upper grade yard.

Study Trips

Study trips are planned by teachers and designed to enhance the curriculum. A permission slip will be sent to you in advance of any Study trip and will include cost, place departure, time, and dress. The permission slip must be signed and returned to your child's teacher in order for the student to participate in the study trip. Parents with volunteer badges are frequently asked to chaperone, and teachers rely on these parents to provide supervision for a group of students. This is one way parents can participate with his/her child in an educational activity and to assist the classroom teacher. Study trips are fun for the students and are intended to be extensions of the classroom curriculum; however, these activities are a privilege that can be lost at the discretion of the teacher.

In order to gain admission to end of the year study trips, students must:

- 2nd Grade Earn at least 10 Accelerated Reader Points
- 3rd Grade Earn at least 20 Accelerated Reader Points
- 4th Grade Earn at least 40 Accelerated Reader Points
- 5th Grade Earn at least 50 Accelerated Reader Points
- 6th Grade Earn at least 75 Accelerated Reader Points (or 750,000 words read)

6th Grade Promotion Activities

The sixth grade is a crucial year in a student's life. It represents the bridge between childhood and adolescence. To be successful later in life, we encourage our students to begin taking a large responsibility for their own work. For this reason, we have set high behavioral and academic standards for our sixth grade students as they prepare to enter

middle school. In order to participate in study trips, promotion exercises, and activities, each student must meet these goals:

- Attend 75% of school days
- Earn 75 Accelerated Reader Points or read 750,000 words
- Complete at least 2 research projects
- Publish 6/8 Writer's Workshop finished pieces
- Achieve at least average of 6/8 on weekly Illuminate quizzes.

We understand that no student wants to be excluded from promotion activities, but we feel that it is far more important that every student learns that there is a direct connection between hard work and the rewards of success. It is our hope that Verde students will learn the value of self-discipline now.

Attendance and Tardy Policy

Your child's attendance and tardy patterns have a direct link with achievement. Frequent absences and tardies hurt academic performance. California State Law mandates that unless children are ill, they must be in school on time every day. Absences are considered excused for the following reasons:

- 1. Student illness or Student medical appointment
- 3. Bereavement
- 4. Some religious observances

For any of the above reasons, parents must notify their child's school office within 24 hours. This can be done by phone (510-231-1408). When your child returns to school, you should send an absence note with an explanation for the child's absence from school if you have not communicated by phone. ALL other absences are considered unexcused. After 3 unexcused absences or 3 unexcused tardies (30 minutes or more), a student is considered "truant" and a form letter notifying parents will be sent home. Habitual excused tardies of 10 or more will also warrant a review and form letter for truancy. More information is also available in the *West Contra Costa Unified School District's Parent – Student Handbook*.

TARDINESS is a serious detriment to each child's and each classroom's success. Although excessive tardiness is defined as a child being late in excess of 30 minutes, the habitual tardiness of 5 to 10 minutes is equally detrimental. This is typically the parents' responsibility, however, students will serve a 10 minute detention when they are tardy (excused or unexcused). Please assist your child to learn the valuable lesson of personal responsibility by setting the example for punctuality. It is a most valuable life skill.

Saturday School and Suspensions

In the case that restorative approaches during the day are not effective in changing unwanted student behavior Saturday school will be assigned to support students.

Saturday School or further disciplinary action may be assigned as a consequence for violation of school policy and/or the following conduct:

- Fighting/violence
- Excessive Tardiness
- Disrespectful towards a school staff member
- Obscenity, profanity, or vulgarity

- Causing or threatening to cause harm to another person
- o On-line bullying
- Low AR points or missing classroom assignments

Students are notified of assigned Saturday School Detention by their grade level teacher or the principal, and the date of the assigned Saturday School. Saturday school letter is sent home with student at least two days before assigned Saturday school assignment. Students who disregard a Saturday School assignment without presenting a valid Doctors note risk further disciplinary consequences including a 3 hour detention or Suspension.

Independent Study

If your child must be absent from school for more than five days, an independent Study Contract will keep absences from being unexcused. Please contact the office and your child's teacher a week before the planned absence to have student work prepared. You and your child will sign a "contract" guaranteeing the work will be done and this work must be completed and returned to their teacher in order to complete the process.

Leaving School before Dismissal

If possible, please do not take your child out of school early. It is very disruptive to the class and they miss out on important assignments. If a child needs to be taken out of school before regular dismissal, an adult on the emergency card must report to the office to sign the student out and the office will send for your child. For student safety and to preserve the learning environment please *do not go to the classroom to get your child*.

Homework Policy

Our goal is to have students complete most of their learning and practice at school. However, we ask that families support their child's learning through having them read every night for 20-30 minutes. We expect families to support their child to complete their reading logs and to discuss what they read nightly. Students can also access math sites like Xtra Math through our school website. Thanks for your support on this expectation.

Communication

Contacting your child: In order to protect school security and the integrity of the learning environment; we ask that you do not go directly to your child's class or call the classroom to deliver a message. If it becomes necessary to deliver a message to your child during the school day, please call or come by the school office.

Please make arrangements for lunch, car pools, babysitting, etc. with your child *before* he/she leaves for school in the morning. In the event of an emergency or change of plans, the office staff will relay messages to your child's teacher.

Forgotten Lunches/Homework: Lunches and homework brought to school by parents should be left at the school office and office staff will contact your child to get his/her lunch or homework. Children will not be allowed to use the phone to ask parents to bring forgotten homework.

Student use of Phone: the school phone is to be used for business and emergency purposes only. It is available for use only with permission of the teacher or office personnel. Students will not be allowed to use the phone for such reasons as asking permission to visit a friend, staying for a recreational program, etc. Students are allowed to have cell phones, but they must remain powered off during the school day or they will be confiscated by the office and parents will have to pick them up.

School to Home Communications: Our goal is to keep Verde families well informed about school activities. In the case of a necessary communication or event, a flyer will go home with the student or a Blackboard connect phone calls will go out to communicate with families. Our website will be updated with announcements regularly and you can view our calendar with important events at wccusd.net/domain/324

Health and Safety

Emergency Cards: Emergency forms will be sent home with each child as part of the school packet at the beginning of the school year. Please fill out this card and return it to school as soon as possible. During the school year, please send a note immediately if there are any changes to the emergency information such as address, phone numbers, and/or change of responsible contacts. Unfortunately, your child is the one who will suffer if injuries or illnesses occur and we are unable to reach anyone.

Health Services: Health services are under the supervision of a qualified school nurse. Vision screening, hearing tests and health counseling for students returning from injury or with 504's or IEP's are among the services administered by the

WCCUSD Nursing Department. The Nursing Department can be reached at 510-307-4646.

Illness or Accidents at School: In case of accident requiring the service of a doctor, we request that parents keep us informed of any changes of address or phone numbers. We will make every effort to contact a parent before the child is taken to a doctor. If it is necessary for a student to go home because of illness, contagious health problem, or injury, the parent or person listed on the emergency card (if the parent cannot be contacted) will be requested to pick the child up in the office. Please remember that we cannot keep a seriously ill child at school. In the event of a serious illness or accident, Verde School personnel will:

- 1. Contact parents when possible.
- 2. Contact other authorized persons listed on the child's emergency card
- 3. Contact the child's physician if known, if above persons cannot be reached.
- 4. In extreme emergencies, an ambulance will be called, and the child will be taken directly to a hospital. Parents will be contacted.

If parents have special requests for the emergency plan for their child, they should contact the school office.

Student Medication: Medical treatment is the responsibility of the parent and the family physician. Medications are rarely given at school. The parent is urged to work with the physician to plan a medication schedule for non-school hours. If it is an absolute necessity that medication be given at school:

- 1. We MUST have a written statement from the doctor "detailing the method, amount, and time schedule by which medication is to be taken." (Education Code 49423)
- 2. A signed release from the parents for the school to assist in administering medication.
- 3. Medication must be in a pharmacy container, labeled with the student's name; the name of the medication; proper dosage and instructions; name of the prescribing physician; name of the pharmacy or manufacturer who dispensed the medication.

Exclusions from School: State law requires that children be excluded from school for the following reasons:

- 1. Contagious health problem.
- 2. Lack of immunizations except when having a waiver.
- 3. Children with head lice will be excluded from school until the hair has been treated and **ALL** of the eggs (nits) have been removed. School will regularly check students for lice to ensure safety of all students.

Lunch/Breakfast Program: Children may bring healthy lunches from home or receive a free school breakfast, snack, and lunch. Please refrain from sending sugary snacks and please support us in our "no hot chips or sugary drinks" (10 grams of sugar

or less) Policy. The district provides a nutritious hot lunch program, eligibility forms for free or reduced lunches are available in the school office and ALL parents are strongly encouraged to apply as it impacts our school funding.

Special Treats: If you would like to send a special treat to school with your child, please contact his/her teacher to find a convenient day. We encourage you to consider sugar free/healthful snacks or a fun student activity (ex: art project).

Emergencies/Disasters: In the event of a major disaster (fire, earthquake, or flood) during school hours, children will be kept at school. They will be released only to previously authorized individuals. The exception would be in the event of a serious injury, when we would send the child for emergency medical care. It is absolutely imperative that the Emergency Card and Student Release Card at school be kept current and accurate. It is the primary document used to locate you or the people you've designated to pick up your child. Your child will not be released to anyone who is not on this emergency card. Telephone systems quickly become overloaded in an emergency, so please do not try to phone the school. Instead, come to school or send a person from your emergency card to pick up your child.

Conferences & Report Cards

Home/school communication is extremely important, particularly in regard to student performance. We feel that the teacher, student, and parent share joint responsibility for this communication. At Verde we strive to have students be the leaders of these communications to build student responsibility, leadership, and agency. The formal reporting procedure includes:

- 1. **Parent orientation:** This evening is in August to share with parents the expectations and culture of the school. This is a great time to meet the principal and school community outreach worker and to ask any questions or concerns.
- 2. **Back to School Night:** This is an evening in September set aside for families to familiarize themselves with their child's classroom and school. Teachers invite parents to Back to School Night to explain the curriculum that will be undertaken by the students during the school year. Grade level expectations, classroom expectations, classroom daily schedule, discipline and homework policies will be discussed. Please make arrangements for children on this evening; this is a "parents/guardians only" evening.
- 3. **Parent Teacher conferences:** Toward the end of the first trimester, a conference will be scheduled for all parents of each child. These conferences are student led and are a very important opportunity for you to hear about your child's academic and social growth. Our students take pride in sharing their growth, 100% participation is expected from families.
- 4. **Report Cards:** A report card will be issued at the end of each trimester for all students.
- 5. **Informal Communication:** May take place any time. Please check with the teacher via note or leave a phone message any time you have questions or

concerns. You may also call the office to request to schedule a Student Success Team meeting (SST).

Special Services

Coordination of Services Team (COST): The Coordination of Services Team meets to discuss issues, concerns or problems that might be interfering with an individual student's success in school. The object is to devise an action plan for alternate strategies to assist the child, his/her teacher and parents. Parents are notified and invited to attend these meetings. SST's are usually attended by several teachers with whom the child has had contact, the school principal, and sometimes a school specialist who might be able to provide support and are also available at parent's request.

School Psychologist and Counselor: Our educational psychologist serves Verde Elementary on a regular basis, providing special education testing and observation of students. Both the school psychologist and counselor are available for student mental health services with permission.

Speech and Language Pathologist: Our speech and language specialist is available to help children with special language needs, to act as a resource for the classroom teacher, and to confer with parents.

Learning Center Program: Our Instructional support providers (ISP) teach students who are legally identified as having average or above average ability but who need help academically because of an identified learning disability or students who have been identified as benefiting from academic intervention through the Response To Intervention (RTI) program.

Response to Intervention: Verde strives to use academic assessments to support student learning at all levels. Students who need support will receive intervention through the learning centers during universal access time. Students who do not need additional support will receive "intervention," "on-level," or "above level" instruction during Universal Access time.

School Site Council: The School Site Council (SSC) serves as a governing body in reference to our School Improvement and other funds received such as MRAD, Library, Tech., etc. The committee is made up of five parents, three teachers, one classified employee, and the Principal or designee. This committee can be larger as long as the parents are the majority.
