Increased interactions with students. Moderate frequency. Includes working with small groups of students under a teacher or staff member's direct supervision. Examples: small group tutoring under the supervision of a teacher or Classroom Parent in the presence of a teacher.</p>	<p>High level of availability. Frequent, direct interactions with students. Examples: Mentors, Tutors, Chaperones/Field Trips, or any role that is not continuously supervised by school staff.</p>
