

**West Contra Costa Unified School District
Redistricting Commission
Tentative Timeline**

This timeline provides an overview of the Redistricting Commission (“Commission”) process prior to the 2022 Board Election. These dates are tentative and subject to change as circumstances may require.

September – November 30, 2020.

Application Window. Candidates may submit their application to serve on the Commission.

November – December 2020.

Preliminary Review of Applications. District staff will perform a preliminary review of applications to ensure each candidate meets the statutory requirements set forth in Elections Code section 23003. The Superintendent will then transmit the eligible candidate applications to the Selection Judge.

January 2021 – May 2021.

Selection Judge Appoints Candidates to the Commission. The Selection Judge will review the applications, and appoint seven (7) individuals to serve as members of the Commission.

July 2021.

Census Data Released. It is currently estimated that the 2020 Census data will be released by the end of July, though this date is subject to change.

July 2021 – October 2021.

(At Least) Five Public Hearings and Preparation of Preliminary Plan. The Commission will hold at least one public hearing in each of the District’s five trustee areas to gather public input on the mapping process. The Commission will prepare a preliminary map and accompanying report (“Preliminary Plan”).

October – December 2021.

(At Least) Three Public Hearings to Review Preliminary Plan. The Commission will hold at least three public hearings to consider the Preliminary Plan and gather more public input on potential trustee areas.

January – February 2022.

Adoption of Trustee Areas. The Commission will adopt a Final District Plan, which will include the final map designating trustee areas.
