

## Accessing Online Curricular Resources 2017/18

### My Math (Grades K – 5)

- Open Chrome, and log into your WCCUSD Google account.
- Click on the waffle iron icon (top right). Click on "more". Click on McGraw Hill.
- If McGraw Hill icon isn't there (near Google Classroom), click on Docs or Drive, then click the waffle iron again. That will "wake up" McGraw Hill.

### Big Ideas Math (Grades 6 – 8)

#### Teacher Log-in

- Open Chrome, and log into your WCCUSD Google account.
- Find and click on the "Clever" icon on your desktop.
- If you do not see the icon, go to <https://clever.com/in/wccusd>, or log in to One Login and find and click the Clever icon there.

If you are logging in for the first time, you may need to add the correct class book for your grade level. Here are the steps:

- After you are signed in, click on your name in the top right corner.
- Click "Class Management".
- Click on the pencil icon on the right that says "View".
- On the left column, under "Books", click on "Add Additional Books", and select the correct book (Course 1=6<sup>th</sup>, Course 2=7<sup>th</sup>, Course 3=8<sup>th</sup>).
- Click on "Save Changes". This will give your students access to the online resources.

#### Big Ideas Math Student Login:

- Students sign-in by clicking on the Clever icon (large, blue C) on their desktop. This should open a page that shows West Contra Costa USD, and a box below that says "Log on with Google". Click on that box. Students then choose the Big Ideas Learning app.

- If there is no Clever icon on their desktop, students can go to [bigideasmath.com](http://bigideasmath.com) and click on “Login with Clever”.

\*Pearson Algebra I (All middle and high school Algebra I students)

- Sign-in from PowerSchool
- Open PowerSchool. Click on the apps icon on the top right.  
(cube with an arrow)
- Select Pearson. That assigns materials to students in classes.
