

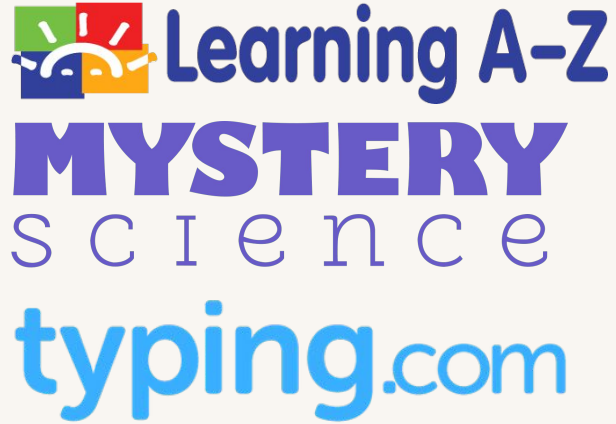

## Students currently at PMS

- Addendum IEP will be sent home for parent consent with change of school ONLY
- All services and supports will remain unchanged in the IEP and will be available at Crespi
- Parents may request an IEP

## Current 6th Grade Students

- Transition IEPs are being schedule now to discuss program, placement and services for middle school

Transportation will be offered to students who do not reside in the Crespi attendance area (bussing or mileage reimbursement)
