WCCUSD is a large urban school district in the San Francisco Bay Area. We cover seven cities, and serve a diverse demographic of students. The psychology department is staffed by approximately 60 school psychologists. There are fieldwork and intern opportunities at the preschool, elementary, middle, high school, and transition (age 18 to 22 years) level. Additionally, the district has a range of programs from full inclusion to special day classes for students with severe disabilities. Fieldworkers and interns will complete a variety of initial and triennial assessments (e.g., autism, specific learning disabilities, emotional disturbances, intellectual disabilities, etc.). There are many counseling, consultation, and behavior intervention training opportunities as well. Our centralized office space allows for collaboration with school psychologists in the department in addition to one's own supervisor. We have licensed clinical psychologists, marriage and family therapists, licensed clinical social workers, and board certified behavior analysts on staff. Training on topics relevant to the field are offered by psychologists on staff who have developed expertise in specific areas important to the practice of school psychology.
