B. English

MCHS classes: English 1, 2, 3, & 4

CCC courses: English 1A, English 1C, La Raza 130

C. Mathematics

MCHS classes: Geometry, Algebra 1

CCC courses: (Math 120 doesn't transfer to UCs or CSUs) Math 121, 135, 164, 171,

190, 191, 200, 290, etc.



D. Science (D1=Life Science, D2=Physical Science)

MCHS classes: Biology mark as a D1

CCC courses: Anthropology 140 = D1, Biosc 110 = D1, Chemistry 119 & Physics 110

= D2



E. Language Other Than English

MCHS classes: Spanish 1, 2, & 3

(If you came to MCHS as a sophomore, you may have a different language for your freshman year; French, Japanese, American Sign Language, those are all high school

classes.)



F. Visual and Performing Arts

CCC courses: Drama 101, 122, 106

(Most of you will only have CCC courses here, unless like mentioned in the E area, you attended a different high school as a freshman)



G. College Prep Electives

MCHS classes: Economics, Senior Project

CCC courses: Adjus 120, 121, Health 120, Counseling 103B, 120, BOT 210A (for CSUs only), Speech 120, 121, CIS 135, Psychology 220, Journal 110 (you may have other courses on your CCC transcript, use the CCC Course Catalog to see if they transfer to UC, CSU, or when you meet with me I can explain if they are.)
