Collins Elementary's vision is to ensure that all students achieve at their highest potential by upholding standards of excellence.

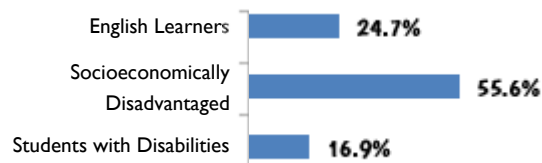

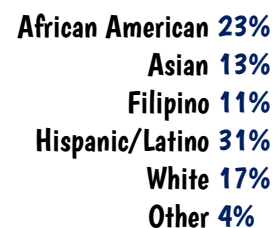
