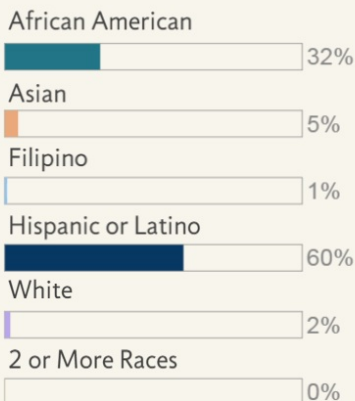
## \$51,826 Total Site LCAP Allocation
