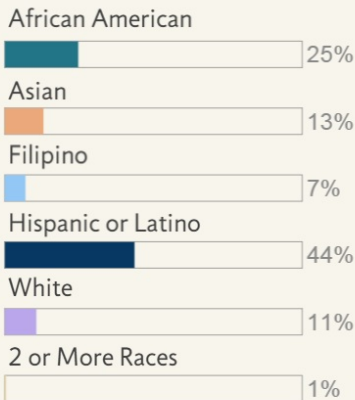
## \$115,773 Total Site LCAP Allocation
