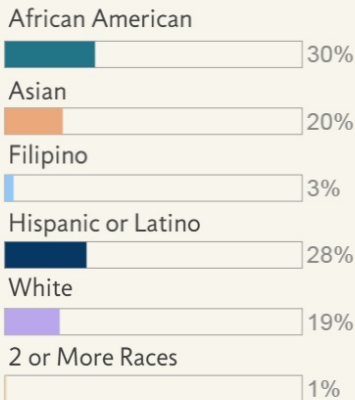


\$91,529 Total Site LCAP Allocation
