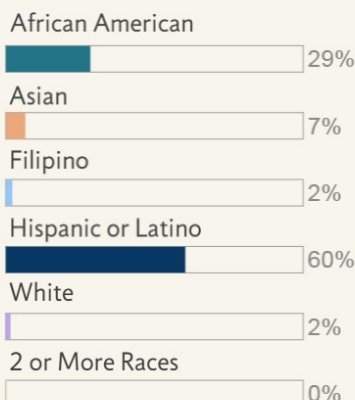


## \$93,014 Total Site LCAP Allocation
