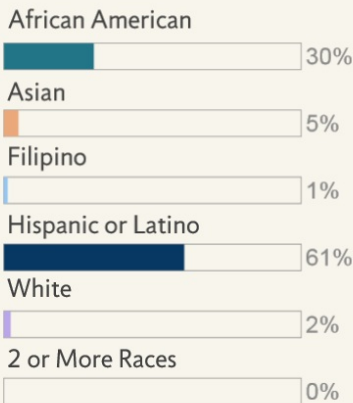


## \$56,331 Total Site LCAP Allocation
