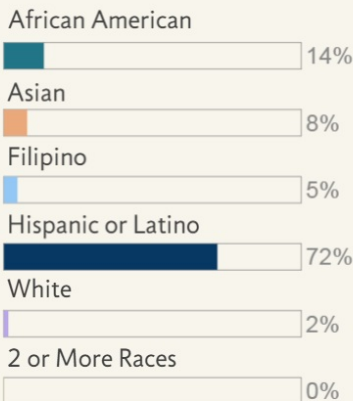


\$52,567 Total Site LCAP Allocation
