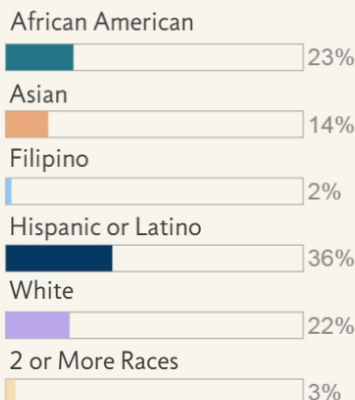


## \$45,624 Total Site LCAP Allocation
