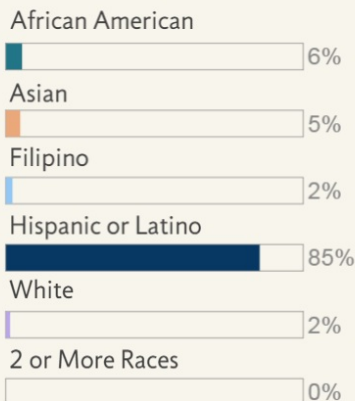
\$176,503 Total Site LCAP Allocation
