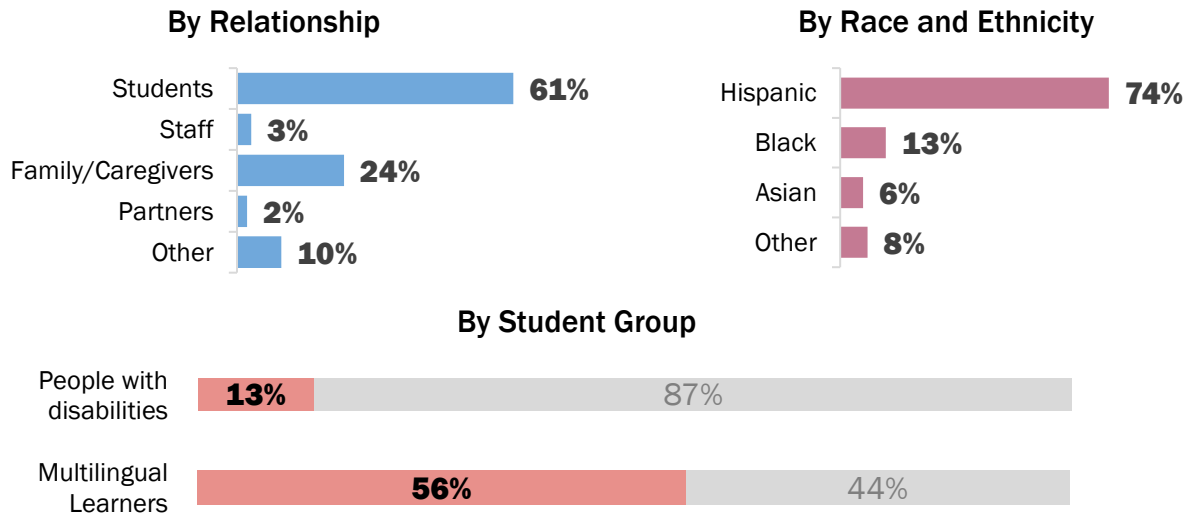


## Design Priorities Survey

Opened August 2, 2023

### Who responded

The current report reflects only the (308) respondents who completed the survey.



### What we did

Students, parents and caregivers, staff, and community partners were asked during Orientation Days, outreach events, and through WCCUSD communications to complete a survey prioritizing the listening insights from the student workshops and small group interviews. Presented with **(42) insights** across **(12) themes, respondents prioritized their top (6) issues** that the new school design must address.

### What we learned

#### Top 6 Priorities Overall

- Safe, healthy, well-built facility
- Addressing students' stress, anxiety, and fear
- Mental health of students
- Respect for and celebration of the linguistic, cultural, and racial identities of students and families
- Staff success and well-being
- Optimal spaces for learning

The **top six priorities are shared by** participants who identify as **students, caregivers and families, and Hispanic or Latino/a/x.**

**Black respondents** prioritized five of the six.

#### Additional Priorities

- High expectations for students
- Parents and caregiver resources and services
- A fair investment relative to what other schools received
- Rigorous academic programs, Welcoming and aspirational facility, Student interests and passions, Community identity and gathering

In addition to the above, Black respondents prioritized these issues in their selections.

This priority was **shared by Black participants and by students.**
