Election Methods

- ❑ **At-large elections:** Each trustee is elected by all voters within the District **(Subject to challenge under the CVRA)**
- ❑ **Trustee-area elections:** Each trustee must reside within the designated trustee area boundary, and is elected only by the voters in that trustee area. Also known as “district-based” elections **(Exempt from potential CVRA violation)**
- ❑ District moved to by-trustee area elections for the 2020 election



Why Revisit the Map?

- ❑ **Required by Education Code section 5019.5**
- ❑ After each decennial federal census, a school district in which trustee areas have been established shall adjust the trustee area boundaries
- ❑ This is to ensure the population balance of each trustee area is nearly equal to each other area

Criteria for Drawing Trustee Areas



- Education Code section 1002(a) allows consideration of*:
 - Topography
 - Geography
 - Cohesiveness, contiguity, integrity, and compactness
 - Communities of interest

- *The demographer, once selected, will go into greater detail



Role/Purpose of Commission

Redistricting Commission is:

- Authorized by California Elections Code section 23000 et seq.
- Empowered to adopt the district boundaries of a legislative body (ultimately responsible for the approval of the map)
- Responsible for preparing and adopting the District's trustee area boundaries for the 2022 Board election, which will be used up to and including the 2030 Board election













Process

- ❑ Commission's process will be dictated by:
- ❑ Elections Code sections 23000, et seq.
- ❑ Stipulation and Judgement in Case of *Ruiz Lozito v. WCCUSD*
- ❑ Any local procedure adopted by the Commission and consistent with the foregoing





Process

- ❑ Within 60 days of appointment, the Commission shall meet and adopt a budget for the Board's approval
- ❑ Commission will hold five public hearings, one in each trustee area, for residents to comment on the drawing of District boundary lines
- ❑ After the public hearing, the Commission's demographer will prepare a preliminary trustee map and an accompanying report to file with the District Superintendent by October 1*
- ❑ *Due to delays in the release of the 2020 Census data, this timeline is an issue to be discussed



Process (Continued)

- ❑ Commission will then hold at least three public hearings on the preliminary trustee map and gather further public input
- ❑ After these public hearings, the Commission will make any necessary revisions before approving a new, “recommended” trustee map and plan to file with the District Superintendent by January 1
- ❑ The District Governing Board must hold at least one public hearing on this new, recommended map
- ❑ After this final Board hearing, the Commission may make any revisions before adopting a final map



Transparency Requirements

- Conduct an open and transparent process that ensures full and meaningful public participation
- Adopt procedures to ensure that any communication received directly or indirectly from incumbent trustees is reduced to writing and posted on the Internet
- Afford maximum public access to proceedings (i.e., setting accessible meeting times and locations, providing notice of meetings and translation services in Spanish)
- Members subject to District's Conflict of Interest Code (provided to applicants)





The Brown Act

(Gov. Code sections 54950, et seq.)

- All meetings must be public, with notice and an agenda
- A quorum of Commission members may not discuss Commission business outside of a noticed public meeting
- This applies to email or social media



Proposed Timeline and Next Steps



- ❑ **Tonight:** potential adoption of proposed budget and proposed process for hiring special legal counsel and demographer
- ❑ **Future Meeting:** appoint a Commission Chair and interview special legal counsel and demographer applicants
- ❑ **October 1, 2021:** file first trustee map and plan with Superintendent; receive and review the 2020 Census data once released
- ❑ **January 1, 2022:** file second trustee map and plan with Superintendent
- ❑ **Moving Forward:** hold necessary public hearings and adopt final map by approximately February of 2022 to allow ample time for the Registrar of Voters to implement the new map boundaries
