JROTC – Air Force Approval – Bruce Harter

In February 2014, the Board gave direction to the Superintendent to initiate a JROTC unit at DeAnza High beginning with the 2014-15 school year with the District paying the entire cost of the program for two years. At that time, the Air Force was not in a position to assume the costs for an AFJRTOC unit at DAHS but had agreed to allow the program to begin as an NDCC unit – basically an AFJROTC with the District paying the full cost. On June 11, 2014, the Board formally approved adding JROTC at DAHS as an NDCC unit with the understanding that the District would pick up the cost that is typically provided by the Air Force for two years. This week I was officially informed that the Air Force would transition the NDCC unit at DAHS to full Air Force JRTOC status for the 2015-16 school year. This results in a savings to WCCUSD of approximately \$100,000. The evaluation of the program, which will be completed by district staff, will begin this spring with a report to the Board early in the fall of this year. The evaluation will include measures of student academic success, program climate as well as student satisfaction.
