Williams Act Quarterly Report – Lisa LeBlanc

The District received one Williams Act complaint during the July 1, 2016 – September 31, 2016 quarter. On September 15, 2016 a complaint pertaining to insufficient quantities of instructional materials in the third grade classroom at Collins Elementary School was submitted to the district. The principal had reported the shortage of My Math books to district staff and a new warehouse order was submitted on September 8, 2016. The order was received at the school site on September 15, 2016. It is not the district's practice to attach the complaint and response as part of Williams precis as they may contain confidential information pertaining to parents, teachers or students. A copy of the complaint and response may be viewed in the superintendent's office.

Implementation Task Force – Lisa LeBlanc

The Implementation Task Force met on Friday, October 21st. The Forensic Audit background and summary of the 112 recommendations were discussed. The public comments received through October 20, 2016 were distributed and the taskforce decided to make them available on the District's website and to take them into consideration when the specific recommendations were implemented. A draft format for an implementation plan was agreed upon which will contain a background summary and two appendices to track and monitor the recommendations. The meeting frequency of the taskforce was decided, along with the timing of reporting to the Facilities Subcommittee and the Board of Education. The next meeting of the taskforce will be held in December with a report to the Facilities Subcommittee in February and the Board of Education thereafter.

Governance Handbook Revisions – Matt Duffy

On November 2, 2016, Harold Freiman will be presenting proposed revisions to the Governance Handbook. The proposed revisions are the result of the Forensic Audit recommendations. The redlined version of the handbook, along with a memorandum from Mr. Freiman and a chart of explanation, is available on Agenda-on-Line. If there are any questions prior to November 2, 2016, please contact me or Lisa LeBlanc, Associate Superintendent.

Funding for Property Purchase – Sheri Gamba

At the August 10, 2016 Board Meeting approval was given for Resolution No. 18-1617 to move forward with the purchase of property currently occupied by the Business Services and Facilities Operations Departments. (1400 Marina Way South). One component of the purchase is to approve

the forms required for financing the property. Approval of these forms does not finalize the property purchase, which must be completed in accordance with the Purchase Sale Agreement which was also part of the August 10th approval. Certain conditions and contingencies must be in place before the sale can be complete, and the debt will not be issued until and unless all conditions and contingencies are compliant. However, in order to be prepared for the sale and closing in a timely manner it is necessary to review and approve the financing documents. These documents will be included in the agenda for November 2. Rudy Salo, Attorney with Nixon Peabody, has prepared a letter explaining the documents, which is enclosed with this memo. He will be at the November 2 meeting to answer any questions you may have regarding the documents.

Edmentum – Blended Learning Platforms – Nia Rashidchi

- *Plato* for Credit Recovery (High School)
- Study Island and Accucess for Academic Coaching (African-American)

Edmentum blended learning platforms allow for the integration of technology and online learning with direct instruction and face to face activities which allows for more individualized and differentiated instruction and also aligns to our one to one initiative.

The *Plato* **platform** provides students in grades 9-12 access to credit recovery for all our core content classes - English 1, 2, and 3, Foundations, US History, World History, US Government and Economics, World Languages, Algebra 1 and 2, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, Biology, Chemistry and Physics to name some. All courses are a-g aligned.

Our current online program Cyber High is in use at most high schools for credit recovery but it is lacking in rigor. Plato has been used successfully for the past 3 years in our summer credit recovery program. We want to do a pilot with *Plato* this school year with the goal of using *Plato* in 2017-18 as our Credit Care program. The pilot would occur with the following schools: El Cerrito HS, Greenwood, PVHS and Vista HS. Each site would have an administrator, a counselor and a teacher/proctor assignment to the Credit Care team. If available, a graduate tutor is also an important member of the team. The team initial meeting would focus on an audit of senior transcripts prioritizing the students who most can benefit from the program and then focus on grades 9-11 who are not on track to graduate.

Once Plato is purchased as our credit recovery program we can use other Edmentum content, including CTE courses, academic intervention and SBAC preparation. We would also receive discounts on the ED option *Academy*, which provides a virtual teacher for core courses. The goal is to reduce the number of students in HS needing to attend summer school for credit recovery and instead

provide our students opportunities to participate in college and career development programs such as internships and other academic programs like Upward Bound.

The Study Island and Accucess platforms will be used in our newly launched Academic Coaching Program "Mafanikio," which provides after school academic and enrichment support to our African-American students at 11 schools: King, Lincoln, Mira Vista, Nystrom, Sheldon, Stege, DeJean Middle, Hercules Middle, El Cerrito, Kennedy, and Vista High School.

Re: Executive Summary of Proposed Action on Certificates of Participation

Members of the Board:

Nixon Peabody LLP, as Bond Counsel to the District, and other members of the finance team, have prepared a number of legal documents for consideration by the Board of Education at its November 2, 2016, meeting that would authorize the execution and sale of up to \$5,250,000 of the District's Certificates of Participation, Series 2016A (the "Certificates"). This Executive Summary outlines the parameters of the action proposed to be taken by the Board and the correlative action to be taken by the Board of Directors (the "Corporation Board") of the West Contra Costa Unified School District Financing Corporation, the District's captive nonprofit corporation (the "Corporation").

Under the Education Code of the State, the District is authorized to enter into lease-purchase transactions from time to time in order to finance acquisitions of school facilities. The District has entered into lease-purchase transactions on several occasions in the past, including through the execution and delivery of its 2005 Taxable Certificates of Participation (2005 Refinancing Project). Lease Payments due in connection with the Certificates, or any other lease-purchase or other leasing arrangement, are payable from the General Fund of the District. The proceeds of the Certificates will be used to finance the purchase of a portion of the property currently located at 1400 Marina Way South in the City of Richmond (the "Property") that the District currently occupies and leases. By purchasing the property the District will be paying less in debt service payments on the Certificates than it currently does in rent resulting in lower payments from the General Fund. In order to do this, the following documents, having the following purposes, have been submitted to the Board:

<u>Authorizing Resolution</u>. This Resolution authorizes the execution and delivery of the Certificates and approves other legal documents necessary for the transaction, listed below. The Resolution also delegates to the Superintendent, the Associate Superintendent, Business

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Services, the Executive Director of Business Services (Bonds), or any member of the Governing Board or any designee thereof the power to finalize the terms of the Certificates within certain parameters. The Resolution confirms the appointment of specialized consultants to accomplish the issuance of the Certificates, including Bond Counsel, KNN as the Financial Advisor and Piper Jaffray & Co., as placement agent ("Piper"). Pursuant to the Resolution, the Certificates will be sold in a direct placement with a purchaser, likely a commercial bank (the "Purchaser"), to be selected pursuant to the delegation authorized under the Resolution. A direct placement is advantageous for the District because it will not require the preparation of a disclosure document or separate ratings of the District for the Certificates, which will reduce the overall costs of issuance of the Certificates.

<u>Site Lease.</u> Under the Site Lease, between the District and the Corporation, the District designates the Property and leases it to the Corporation for the term of the Certificates. The District never loses use and possession of the Property under this arrangement.

<u>Lease Agreement</u>. Under the Lease Agreement, again between the District and the Corporation, the District leases the Property back from the Corporation and agrees to pay semiannual Lease Payments (the "Lease Payments") to the Corporation, in amounts sufficient to pay the principal and interest with respect to the Certificates. Pursuant to the Lease Agreement, the District is required to budget the Lease Payments, provide adequate insurance for the Leased Property and comply with applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Code applicable to the use of the Property. A Memorandum of the Lease Agreement will be executed and recorded with the Contra Costa County Recorder's Office.

<u>Trust Agreement and Assignment Agreement</u>. Under the Trust Agreement, among the District, the Corporation and The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A., as trustee (the "Trustee"), the Trustee will execute and deliver the Certificates to the Purchaser and will apply the net proceeds (1) to pay for the acquisition of the property; (2) to pay for certain improvements of the Property; and (3) to pay the costs of issuance of the Certificates. The Corporation will assign all of its interests in the Lease Payments to the Trustee at closing pursuant to the Assignment Agreement. The assigned Lease Payments will be used to pay principal and interest on the Certificates held by the Purchaser.

<u>Placement Agreement</u>. The Placement Agreement provides the general terms under which Piper will agree to place the Certificates with the Purchaser.

<u>Miscellaneous Certificates and Opinions</u>. There are, of course, a number of other certificates and opinions that will be necessary in order for the District to complete this transaction, and the Resolution provides that the Superintendent, the Associate Superintendent, Business Services, the Executive Director of Business Services (Bonds), or any member of the Governing Board or any designee thereof may approve those as they are needed.

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In addition to the Action Item submitted to the Board, the Corporation Board will take a similar action to approve the legal documents that it must execute. The Board will also adopt a reimbursement resolution that allows the District to issue the Certificates on a tax-exempt basis and reimburse itself for amounts the District advanced for the purchase of the Property.

We look forward to the Board meeting and answering any further questions that you may have concerning the above.


