**K-5 Adoption Committee Update**

In preparation for recommendation for new K-5 mathematics curriculum for SY 24-25, the [K-5 Math Adoption Committee](#) has carefully analyzed five high quality curricula and, using [agreed-upon selection criteria](#), voted to pilot Great Minds' Eureka Math Squared and Kendall Hunt's Illustrative Mathematics (IM). Teachers received pilot training, classroom materials, and manipulatives for Eureka Math Squared and have begun classroom piloting one entire unit of their choice. Two check-in meetings have been planned during the piloting period and in December the committee will debrief their findings. Kendall Hunt's IM training and piloting period will begin in January. The pilot committee will vet both texts using an [Anti-Bias Screener based on these criteria](#).

**School Attendance Review Team (SART) Collaborative**

To address the constantly growing need for enhancing attendance improvement strategies through practical resources, professional development, and capacity building, a SART Collaborative was established in September 2023.

This initiative aims to improve attendance and develop effective strategies to address this issue by promoting collaboration between site attendance review teams and offers the opportunity for peer-to-peer dialogue, troubleshooting and assessment of district wide best practices.

Brainstorming with colleagues can help generate fresh ideas and perspectives to develop messaging strategies that resonate with students and parents. By working together, teachers, administrators, and other stakeholders can pool their knowledge and experience to develop innovative solutions to address absenteeism.

Attendance Teams are encouraged to join the SART Collaborative discussions every third Wednesday of the month, in a morning or afternoon session. With this initiative, we hope to support our Student Wellness Goals to increase overall district attendance rates by 3%, from 91% to 94%.
