We were recently attacked by the Ransom virus. It is activated when someone clicks on a malicious attachment or link. This virus encrypts the computer's files making them unreadable. A phone number is then displayed stating that if a ransom is paid, the files will be restored. The virus infected some of the Bond servers, to include the CBOC website server, project server and Primavera, which is hosted by an outside company. To combat the spread of the virus, we have tightened up our fire wall and are deploying a new virus protection program. Although I haven't been informed regarding the Primavera server, the rest of the servers were restored using our backups.
