#### Forensic Audit Implementation - Engineering/Professional Services- Lisa LeBlanc

The forensic audit has a specific recommendation for staff to include historical information related to an add-service request when requesting Board approval (TC13-9). Add-service requests, together with new professional service contracts, typically are considered by the Board under "Approval of Engineering Services". In an effort to improve our practice and implement the recommendations of the forensic audit, the engineering services summary back-up documentation for the Board has a new format commencing with the October 5, 2016 Board meeting. The summary includes a section for new contracts and a separate section for contract amendments (add-services). The first section for new contracts provides specific information including: project, vendor, funding source, contract amount, contract term and scope of services. The second section for contract amendments includes historical information for the contract including the present allowable compensation and the number of amendments previously approved. In addition to the summary revisions, the actual contract or amendment will be provided as back up documentation identifying the full scope and deliverables associated with the proposed changes in fee for full transparency prior to Board approval.

#### Warm Classroom Conditions - Lisa LeBlanc

The District has several schools that do not have air conditioning and there is recognition that hot days at the beginning and end of the school year create teaching and learning challenges. Our Maintenance team has been monitoring building and classroom temperatures, particularly in our two-story classroom buildings. The cost to add air conditioning to an existing school is significant so the team is looking at other ways in which to provide relief. The District will be installing reflective film on exterior windows at Dover Elementary School beginning on Tuesday, October 4<sup>th</sup>. We anticipate being able to reduce the solar energy gain by as much as 50% and lower classroom temperatures. The District is also planning to install reflective film at Chavez, Ford, Harding and Lincoln with anticipated completion by the end of October. Other cooling techniques are also being implemented including: ventilating classrooms at night and turning off heaters in the morning, installing wall fans, opening windows in an effort to improve classroom comfort during warm weather conditions.

# Board of Education Conflict of Interest - High Risk Area from Forensic Audit - Matt Duffy

The Board of Education accepted the Phase II Final Report of the Forensic Audit Investigation on September 21, 2016. Within the report, there were several recommendations relating to high risk areas including Board Member conflict of interest and refraining from performing management

functions. Attorney Harold Freiman, along with District staff, will make recommendations in these areas to revise and/or add language to the Governance Handbook at the November 2, 2016 board meeting.
