WCCUSD Food Services Kicks Off its Summer Meal program, Monday June 11, 2018 -Lisa LeBlanc

The West Contra Costa Unified School District's Food Services is working to make sure that no child in West Contra Costa County goes hungry when schools are closed this summer. Over 16,500 children in West Contra Costa County receive free or reduced-price meals during the school year, but many of these children do not get enough to eat when school is out. The WCCUSD Seamless Summer Feeding Program (SSFP), which starts on Monday, June 11 and runs through Thursday, August 16, 2018, ensures that low-income children continue to grow and learn during the summer. On June 11, 2018, WCCUSD Food Services is kicking off its summer meal program with a special BBQ lunch (free to children 18 years of age and younger) from 11-1:30 PM at its Central Kitchen location at 750 Bissell Avenue, Richmond, CA. This event will include educational activities for the children, taste testing and tours of its state of the art Central Kitchen. Many of our students rely on meals during the regular school year and just because it is summer, their hunger does not take a vacation. Over 70 sites throughout the WCCUSD district in eligible areas are gearing up to serve meals at no charge to children this summer.
