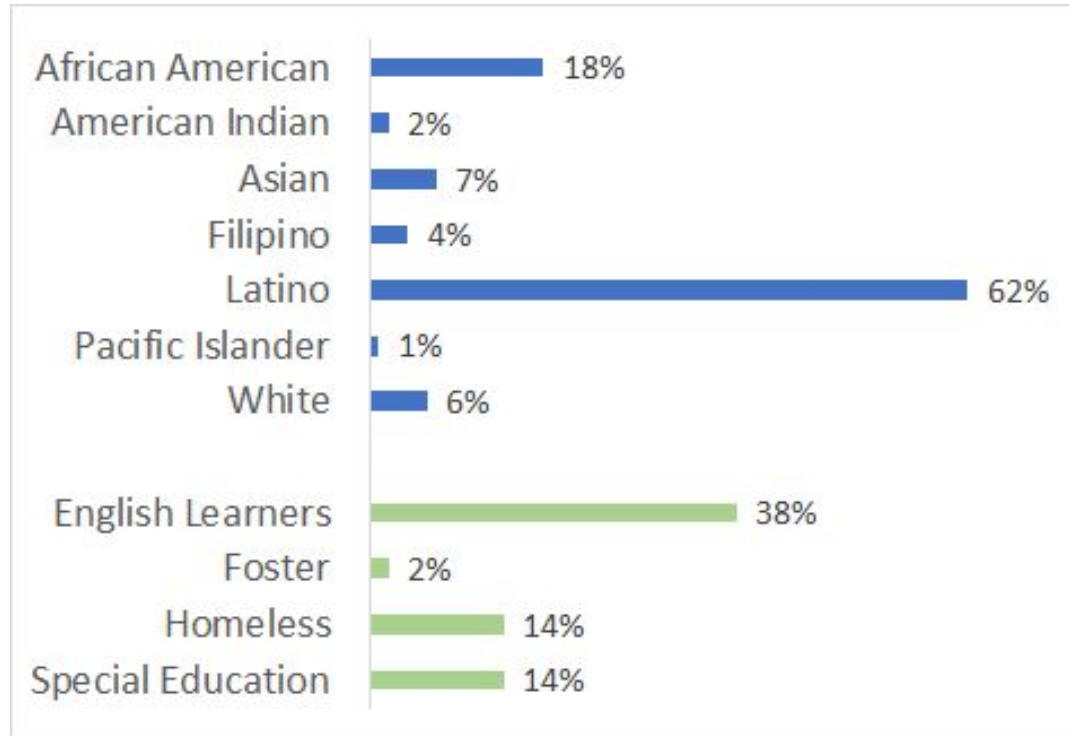

- **25% live in San Pablo**
- 7% in Pinole
- 6% in El Sobrante
- 5% in Hercules
- 4% in El Cerrito
