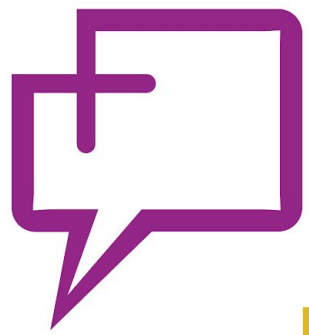

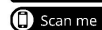

# Opening of School Notes

- Richmond H.S. added three new UC approved courses that examine content area subjects through an Ethnic Studies lens
- Elementary band is up and running on Google Classroom.
- During synchronous math time teachers reporting...70% are checking for understanding, 70% are positively narrating, 85% are encouraging different ways of thinking, 85% are embracing and valuing mistakes, 50% are doing number talks, 90% are ensuring the lesson is at grade-level.
- Amplify for Middle School Science: Teachers have been attending grade specific PD, and implementing "@Home" lessons.
- The FabLab is partnering with Richmond Main Street Initiative on a fundraiser to produce PPE for Richmond residents and small businesses. Travis Credit Union is matching all donations up to \$20,000.
- After a long pause in ELPAC testing, the state has finally given the green light for Remote testing.



# Attendance and Engagement

- A2A will begin to track attendance and engagement by the end of this month
  - Week 1: Weekly average 3,260 students were absent (12%)
  - Week 2: Weekly average 2,401 students were absent (9%)
  - Week 3: Weekly average 2,096 students were absent (8%)
- **22,000+ Chromebooks** are being used daily
- During the last two weeks (Monday through Thursday), students and staff spent over **3 million minutes on Zoom** each day
- There are over **3,000 active Google Classrooms** where teachers have posted 77,011 times since the first day of school.
