
#### CLOSE UP OF REASSIGNED EL SOBRANTE ATTENDANCE AREA

West Contra Costa Unified School District Elementary School Attendance Areas






#### CLOSE UP OF REASSIGNED ADAMS ATTENDANCE AREA

West Contra Costa Unified School District Middle School Attendance Areas


