Strengthening & Stabilizing Stege Update

Certificated Staffing Update:

- Hired 5 classroom teachers & **2 specialist teachers***
 - 3 from within the district (8, 18, & 5 years of experience)
 - 3 from outside (8, 10, & 27 years of experience)
- 6 teachers returning from 18-19 school year

***There have been some adjustments made to the staff since the start of the school year.**

Additional Staffing Update

Additional Personnel for 19-20 outside of classroom teachers

- Full Service Community Schools Coordinator (*position needs to be hired*)
- Grad Tutor - 0.8 FTE (in place)
- Partners Coach - contracted service (in place)
- House substitute teacher (full time) - **see previous slide*
- Upper division tutor - continuing for 19-20 (in place)
- SCOW - (*position needs to be hired*)

Professional Learning

Planning is on the way for the five PD days up front:

- Dates of training were scheduled for August 7-9, 12-13
- Major topics included the following:
 - Teambuilding
 - CPI/De-escalation
 - Restorative Practices
 - Playworks-Group Management/Power of Play
 - Units of Study planning/PD
 - Math planning/PD
 - Technology/Digital Citizenship


Facilities Update

Updates and beautification to the campus include the following:

- New front office furniture
- Campus beautification (paint in classrooms)
- Cypress path better/working lights and grass groomed (*pending - work with City of Richmond*)

Principal's Update

- 267 students enrolled as of 8/26
- Stege students increased in ELA performance by 11 points
- Stege students increased significantly in Math performance by 18 points
- Stege students declined significantly in student suspensions by 2.1%
