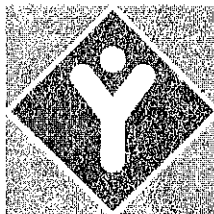

Curriculum and Instruction Provided by Young Champions.

Course Description: Students learn arm motions, hand, leg and feet formations and voice projection. Cheers, chants, and dance movements are taught with flair and enthusiasm by our experienced instructors. Returning students learn advanced techniques. Students are prepared for school team tryouts looking sharp and jazzy!

Registration: Please register 20 minutes before your class time with the instructor at the location you will be attending or pre-register online at www.ChampionYouth.org. If you miss the first week, you may register 10 minutes before your class up to the fourth week.

Class Fees: Only \$8 per lesson if you pay in full for the entire session (\$112), or \$9 if you pay weekly. There is an \$8.00 registration fee paid once per quarter. **Scholarships Available!** Those who pay in full will receive a refund on weeks not taught if session is canceled.
